In 2022, Tamron debut her crime-fiction novel "As The Wicked Watch." In March 2024 she released her second book "Watch Where They Hide" the second book in the Jordan Manning series. Following she released her debut cookbook "A Confident Cook: Recipes for Joyous, No-Pressure, Fun in the Kitchen" in September 2024 as a way to memorialize her late father who was the cook in the family. This March she released her first children's book "Harlem Honey," which became an instant New York Times bestseller.

An outspoken advocate for shedding light on domestic abuse, Hall has partnered with Safe Horizon to launch The Tamron ♥ Renate Fund in honor of her sister to help victims and families affected by domestic violence.
